

6 Easy Steps

#1



Pull Over to a Safe Place

However minor you think a car accident is, you must stop. Make sure to stop in a safe area.

#2



Call the Police or Take Video

A police report will help to build the official record of the accident itself and prevent the other driver from changing their story. If police will not come, take video of other driver and / or witnesses admitting fault.

#3



Take Photos / Video

Take photographs and videos of the vehicles, the accident scene, other person's driver's license, car registration, and insurance card. Take pictures of your injuries immediately after the accident.

#4



Gather Information

Exchange names, addresses, telephone numbers, vehicle registration, insurance company details and policy info with the other drivers, and collect witness name and phone numbers.

#5



Seek Medical Care

If and when symptoms of injury arise, seek medical care immediately.

#6



Contact a Lawyer

You may be entitled to compensation. First contact a lawyer before contacting any insurance company to learn your rights.
